The Dane Maddock Adventures by USA Today bestselling author David Wood brings the classic pulp-style adventure into a modern setting. Inspired by such varied works as the Dirk Pitt Adventures, Indiana Jones, Doc Savage, and The Rocketeer. Whether you grew up watching *In Search of...* or *Ancient Aliens*, there's something here for you. The books are accessible to all adult and young adult readers, with mild language and minimal sexual situations.

THE DANE MADDOCK ADVENTURES

The Dane Maddock Adventures follow the exploits of former Navy SEALs turned treasure hunters, Dane Maddock and "Bones" Bonebrake as they travel around the world solving ancient mysteries, finding artifacts of great power, lost cities, and legendary treasures and creatures. Like an Indiana Jones movie, these stories will often include just a touch of the supernatural.

These books are written so that they may be read in any order, with little allusion to the other books, but if you'd like to read them in chronological order:

DANE MADDOCK ORIGINS

See how it all began!

This series follows Maddock and Bones during their days as Navy SEALs and through to their treasure hunting adventures. Unlike the main series adventures, these stories contain pseudoscience but no supernatural elements. (*These books were all written with co-authors .)

While these books can be read in any order, it is recommended that the reader begin by reading at least the first six books of the Dane Maddock Adventures series (through Atlantis) before reading the Origins or Universe series.



Adventures around the world!


These books may be read in any order, but it is recommended to read *Maug* before *Shasta*. Some contain supernatural elements, others do not.

THE JADE IHARA ADVENTURES

Archaeological thrillers!

Archaeologist Jade Ihara steps out from Maddock's shadow to embark on adventures of her own, with a little help from former Navy SEAL Pete "Professor" Chapman. (These are full-length novels written with bestselling action-adventure author Sean Ellis.)

This series is connected to the Maddock universe through Jade Ihara, who is a recurring character throughout the series, and Pete Chapman, who is a character in the Origins series and in Atlantis.

*The first book in this series takes place after the events of Buccaneer, Dane Maddock book five.

Series order: 1– Oracle 2-Changelings 3-Exile

THE MYRMIDON FILES

International intrigue and adventure.

Tam Broderick and her team of CIA operatives--codenamed: Myrmidons--worked with Dane & Bones to take down the Dominion. Now, the Myrmidons are back and taking on the Dominion around the world.

(These are full-length novels written with bestselling action-adventure author Sean Ellis.)

This series is linked to the Maddock universe through Tam Broderick, who is a recurring character in the main adventures, the Myrmidons, and The Dominion. Maddock and Bones also appear in the series.

*The first book in this series takes place after the events of Atlantis, Dane Maddock book six.

THE BROCK STONE ADVENTURES


Classic pulp-style adventures.

Brock Stone is an homage to the classic pulp stories like Doc Savage. (These are novella-length stories.)



Renegade marine biologist and adventure host Jo Slater search for giant monsters and unexplained phenomena. If you love "creature features" and giant monster thrillers, you'll be thrilled by Sam's exploits.

(Full-length novels written with Australian Shadows Award-winning author Alan Baxter.)

This series is connected to the Maddock universe through Jo Slater, who is a character in a Bones Bonebrake adventure, and is referenced in some of the main series novels. Other characters appear in the Maddock books and the Crowley books.

*These books contain adult language and situations.

THE JAKE CROWLEY ADVENTURES

Adventure with a dark twist!

Jake Crowley and Rose Black travel the world unmasking conspiracies and solving historical mysteries. Like the Dane Maddock series, these books are fast-paced adventures. In this series, the mysteries tend to lean toward conspiracies and the occult. (Full-length novels written with Australian Shadows Award-winning author Alan Baxter.)

Maddock and Bones make an appearance in *Sanctum*, and characters from this series occasionally appear in the Maddock books and the S. The tone of this series is slightly darker than that of the Maddock series and the language and situations slightly more mature.

Series order: 0– Sanctum 1-Blood Codex 2– The Anubis Key 3– Revenant


